### NOTICE TO APPLICANTS

#### Applications For New and Renewal of Phase II Acid Rain Permits

*To determine whether your emission unit is subject to the Acid Rain Program, please review the applicability requirements of the Acid Rain Program in 40 CFR §72.6. Acid Rain Permits are issued in accordance with the provisions for the state issuance of Phase II Acid Rain Permits as set forth in 40 CFR §72.73.*

The following forms are required to be filled out if you are applying for a **New** Acid Rain Permit:

- "[Permit Application Transmittal Form](#)"
- "[Phase II Permit Application Form](#)"
- "[Certificate of Representation Form](#)", only if an Authorized Representative has not already been registered

If you are applying for a **Renewal** of an Acid Rain Permit and the Acid Rain Permit:

- **does not expire upon the incorporation into your Title V permit and expires more than 1 year from the expiration date of your Title V permit**, then you must complete the forms above.
- **does not expire upon the incorporation into your Title V permit but expires less than 1 year from the expiration date of your Title V permit**, then you must submit the Acid Rain Permit renewal application forms as an attachment to your Title V permit application. See the [Title V instructions](#) for more information.
- **does expire upon the incorporation into your Title V permit**, then you must submit the Acid Rain Permit renewal application forms as an attachment to your Title V permit application. See the [Title V instructions](#) for more information.
- **has been fully incorporated into your Title V permit which includes, by reference and attachment, your Acid Rain permit**, then you must submit the Acid Rain Permit renewal application forms as an attachment to your Title V permit application. See the [Title V instructions](#) for more information.

The forms shall be sent as follows (if not being submitted with your Title V application):

#### 1. To the Connecticut DEP:

- Original "Permit Application Transmittal Form"
- Original "Phase II Permit Application Form" and two copies
- Copy of the "Certificate of Representation Form", if required and only if applying for a **new** permit

NOTE: There are no fees associated with a Title IV Acid Rain Permit
