

This document contains the Connecticut regulations for Migratory Bird Conservation Stamp. MIGRATORY BIRD CONSERVATION STAMP

26-27b-1. Migratory bird conservation stamp.

(1) The requirement for possession of a Connecticut Migratory Bird Conservation Stamp while hunting or taking waterfowl shall be in addition to the requirement for possession of a Connecticut small game hunting license and any other permit or stamp required by Connecticut or federal law. The stamp shall not be transferable.

(2) The price of the Connecticut Migratory Bird Conservation Stamp shall be ten dollars. Such stamps shall be issued annually beginning on July first and shall expire on June thirtieth of the following calendar year.
