Dear Mr. Cutler:

The Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Materials Management & Compliance Assurance has accepted your proposal for remediating contaminants in groundwater and soil at petroleum underground storage tank sites designated by the DEP. Loureiro Engineering Associates, Inc. (LEA) will need to agree to the following conditions for the contract to be implemented:


1. Meet with the DEP and potential property owners, to gain access and talk about the scheduling of future work.
2. Provide to the DEP a schedule of proposed work with start dates and expected duration of events for each site.
3. Invoices for each site will be submitted monthly to conform to the Stimulus Reporting requirements. Invoices should be submitted on a time and materials basis as dictated under the terms and conditions of the Contract Award No. 05PSX0271.
4. Disposal of petroleum contaminated soil shall take place at the South Hadley Landfill, when possible, to ensure the tipping fee of \$13/ton.
5. Backfill soils shall be acceptable in material and composition to the DEP staff person on site at the quoted price of \$6/ton.
6. A Health and Safety Plan and scope of work plan shall be submitted to the DEP for review at least 10 business days prior to commencement of work.
7. For sites where dewatering is taking place on a significant scale, a cost/benefit analysis will be performed to consider which option is more feasible, in terms of cost and time:
  - A. Pumping groundwater into a frac tank(s)
  - B. Applying for a permit to discharge to a sewer

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8. Depending on your availability, your firm may be required to work on more than one site at a given time.
9. Your firm will have to be responsive to DEP's requirements for State and Federal reporting.
