- Allure International Academy for Hairdressing and Cosmetology – New London, CT

The Board conducted a hearing the matter of Nina McFerrin. Staff Attorney Joelle Newton was present on behalf the Department of Public Health. Respondent was not present or represented.

The Board unanimously found on all charges as alleged.

Mr. Carrozzella made a motion, seconded by Ms. Duncan, that the respondent be issued a Cease and Desist Order from practicing as a hairdresser unless and until respondent is properly licensed in Connecticut. The motion passed unanimously.

D. Shawn Craig – Petition No. 2010-366

The Board conducted a hearing the matter of Shawn Craig. Staff Attorney Joelle Newton was present on behalf the Department of Public Health. Respondent was not present or represented.

The Board unanimously found on all charges as alleged.

Mr. Carrozzella made a motion, seconded by Ms. Testori, that the respondent be issued a reprimand, a \$2000.00 civil penalty and a Cease and Desist Order from employing unlicensed persons. The motion passed unanimously.
